

## **ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT**

### **The Policy Approach.**

Each unit attending a Folk Camp is owned by the member and is the responsibility of that member. Those attending include able bodied members and disabled members. The site will be arranged to allow full access to all persons.

### **Links to the surrounding road network and footpaths.**

Access to the camping field will be immediately off an existing access road currently serving the site. The access to the field will be level.

### **Movement patterns around and through the site.**

The site will be organised so that each unit has its own pitch. There will be directional signs within the site and a warden on duty. The field will be organised so that vehicles and pedestrians will be able to move safely and easily around the site.

### **Entrances and exits from the marquee and toilets**

The marquee/hall (used for social activities and dining) will be either on ground level with no steps to inhibit access or a ramp will be in place for disabled access. A disabled toilet with suitable access will be on site.

### **Access to public facilities, visibility and land level changes.**

There will be no public access to the site for the duration of the camps. Only booked members will be in attendance. Electric lighting and fluorescent emergency exit signs will be installed in the marquee and toilets. The site will be level. The only steps will be to installed "portaloo's". A disabled toilet will be available with a suitable ramp access.

### **Inclusive access for disabled people.**

Folk Camps operates an inclusive attendance policy and there will be both able bodied and disabled members on site at various times

### **Emergency access and egress of the marquee/hall and the site.**

Each unit will have its own individual access and egress points. For health and safety purposes emergency vehicles will be able to gain access to any unit on the site. As such, units will be well spaced and sited so they do not restrict access to, or exit from, any other unit or the site in general. At least 3 metres will be required between units in all circumstances. For this purpose, a unit includes the caravan, motor home, tent or trailer-tent, plus any awnings, gazebo or pup-tent and the car or towing vehicle.
