Folk Camps Accessibility Policy

Those attending Folk Camps include able-bodied members and disabled members and our camps sites are arranged to allow full access to all facilities. Campers with special requirements are encouraged to contact our Administrator when they book to discuss any special arrangements.

Links to the surrounding road network and footpaths.

Access to the camping field will be immediately off an existing access road currently serving the site. The access to the field will be as level as is possible given that sites are often on agricultural land.

Movement patterns around and through the site.

Each unit (tent, caravan, motorhome) at a Folk Camp site is owned by the member and is the responsibility of that member. The site will be organised so that each has its own pitch. There may be directional signs within the site and each camp site has an allocated Warden to assist campers to pick the best location for their needs. The field will be organised so that vehicles and pedestrians will be able to move safely and easily around the site.

Entrances and exits from the marquee/hall and toilets

The marquee/hall (used for social activities and dining) will be either on ground level with no steps to inhibit access, or a ramp will be in place for disabled access. A disabled toilet with suitable access will be on site.

Access to facilities

Electric lighting and fluorescent emergency exit signs will be installed in the marquee/hall. A disabled toilet will be available with suitable access. All facilities – washing up area, vegetable preparation area, etc. – will be made accessible. Where steps to a hall are unavoidable, a suitable ramp will be provided.

Emergency access and egress

Emergency vehicles will be able to gain access to any unit on the site.
